### Nearly \$300,000 in capital improvements

We invested nearly \$300,000 in our facility last year which included technology replacement, information technology additions/updates, and important facility upkeep and maintenance.

### Contributing to our local tax base

Last year, Bluegrass Community Hospital paid \$592,204 in property and sales taxes which helped support our city, county and state. These dollars help support local schools, develop roads, recruit business and industry, and provide other important services.

### Helping those In need

Bluegrass Community Hospital provided more than \$16.1 million in uncompensated care last year, which included the amounts not covered by Medicare and Medicaid. This amount includes \$3 million for charity care and bad debt, incurred as we served many people without the financial resources to pay for basic health services.

### Adding to the medical staff

During the past year, Bluegrass Community Hospital has added a number of new physicians to our highly respected medical staff, including specialists in cardiology, nephrology, ophthalmology, otolaryngology and pain management.

### One of our community's major employers

With an annual payroll of more than \$6.1 million and 133 employees, Bluegrass Community Hospital is one of the largest employers in the region.
