### **More than \$500,000 in capital improvements**

In 2010, we added new equipment, including an ER Central Monitoring System and a new fire alarm system, as well as upgrading our parking lot.

In fact, we invested \$538,324 in our facility during 2010 which included technology replacement, information technology additions/updates, and important facility upkeep and maintenance.

### **Contributing to our local tax base**

Last year, Georgetown Community Hospital paid more than \$1.7 million in taxes to help support our city, county and state. These dollars help maintain local schools, development of roads, recruitment of business and industry, and other vital community services.

### **Helping those in need**

Georgetown Community Hospital provided more than \$61.4 million in uncompensated care last year, which includes the amounts not covered by Medicare and Medicaid. The amount includes more than \$10.6 million for charity care and bad debt, incurred as we served many people without the financial resources to pay for basic health services.


### **Adding new physicians**
